Guidelines for applicants to the 2016 summer camp in China:

- 1) Must be a CEGEP or University student;
 - 2) Must be in good health for long distance travel;
 - 3) Must possess good English communication skills;
 - 4) Must have knowledge of Quebecois and Canadian culture.
- Students will be responsible for the cost of return international airfare from Canada to China and for their own medical insurance. Return airfare from Montreal to Shanghai from Aug.1 - 15 will cost approximately \$1 300 - \$1 500 (via Air Canada);
 - Accommodation and transportation in China will be provided by the Confucius Institute in Quebec
